Sewing Machine & Instruction Manual	Extra Bobbins for your machine

CLASS FEES MUST BE PAID ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF FIRST CLASS.

All fabrics should be woven cotton and pre-washed prior to class. Just put it in the washer with like colors and wash & dry as usual. Press with an iron on the correct temperature setting if needed.

Class # 1 Project: Learn Your Machine: This is primarily instruction getting to know your machine, an overview of fabrics, patterns, measuring & cutting techniques, etc. We will be making a simple tissue holder with the fat quarter.

Class # 2 Project: Pillow Case: 1-yard cotton for main body of pillow case and 1/3 yard for band. Thread to match project. We will talk about the pants pattern in this class, and start tracing the pattern.

Class # 3 Project: Pull on Pajama Pants Part 1. Bring your*Sew Easy Pajama Pants* pattern and all supplies listed on the pattern to class. We will cut out pattern and fabric in class.

Class # 4 Project: Pull on Pajama Pants Part 2. We will continue working on and finishing the Pajama pants.

Some suggestions to make our classes more informative, fun, and fulfilling:

1. Make sure your machine is in good working order when you come to class.
2. Complete your homework assignments so that the class can stay together on classroom instruction.
3. Try to arrive 15 min. early and have your project organized at the beginning of class.

The patterns and projects for this class have been selected to teach you some of the basics of sewing. Please do not ask to change any of the patterns at this basic level.

Minimum age for this class is 13 yrs old with parent present for all classes

There are no make-up classes!! If you are unable to attend all of the classes for the month, please consider taking the next session and let someone on the waiting list take your place.
